**God.**

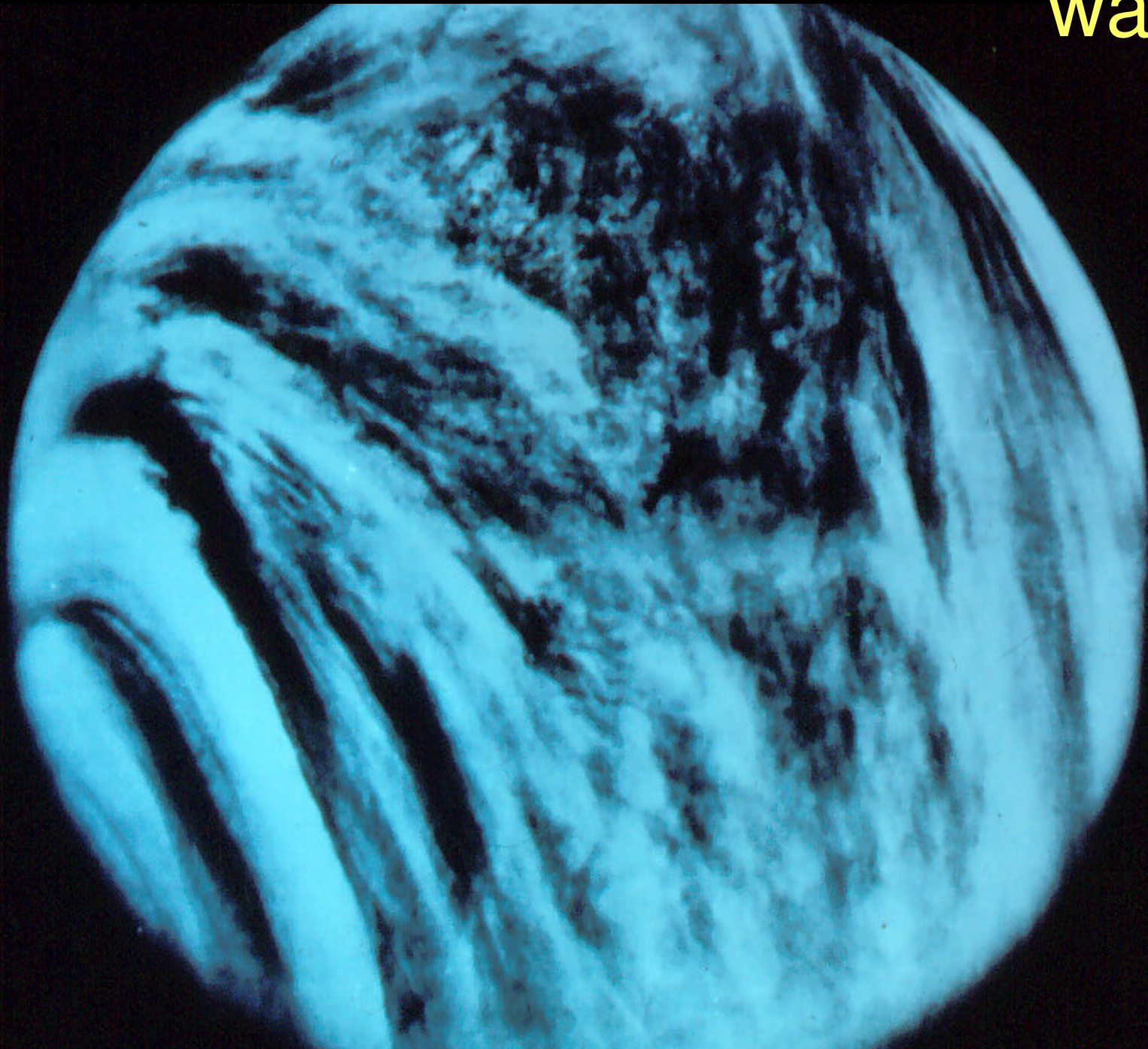
**Genesis 1:5**

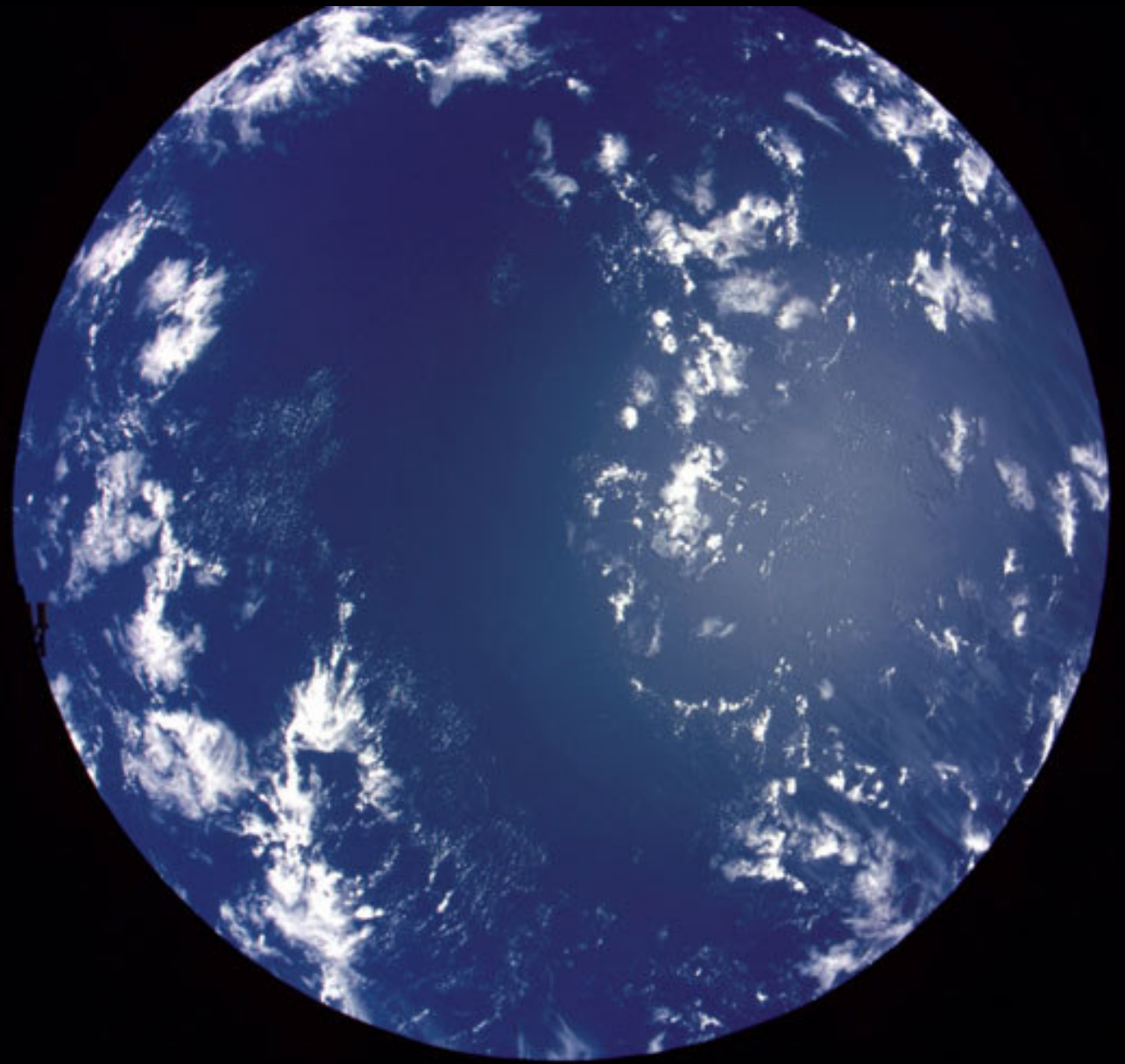




## Day 2.

**together into one place, and let the dry land appear”; and it was so.**



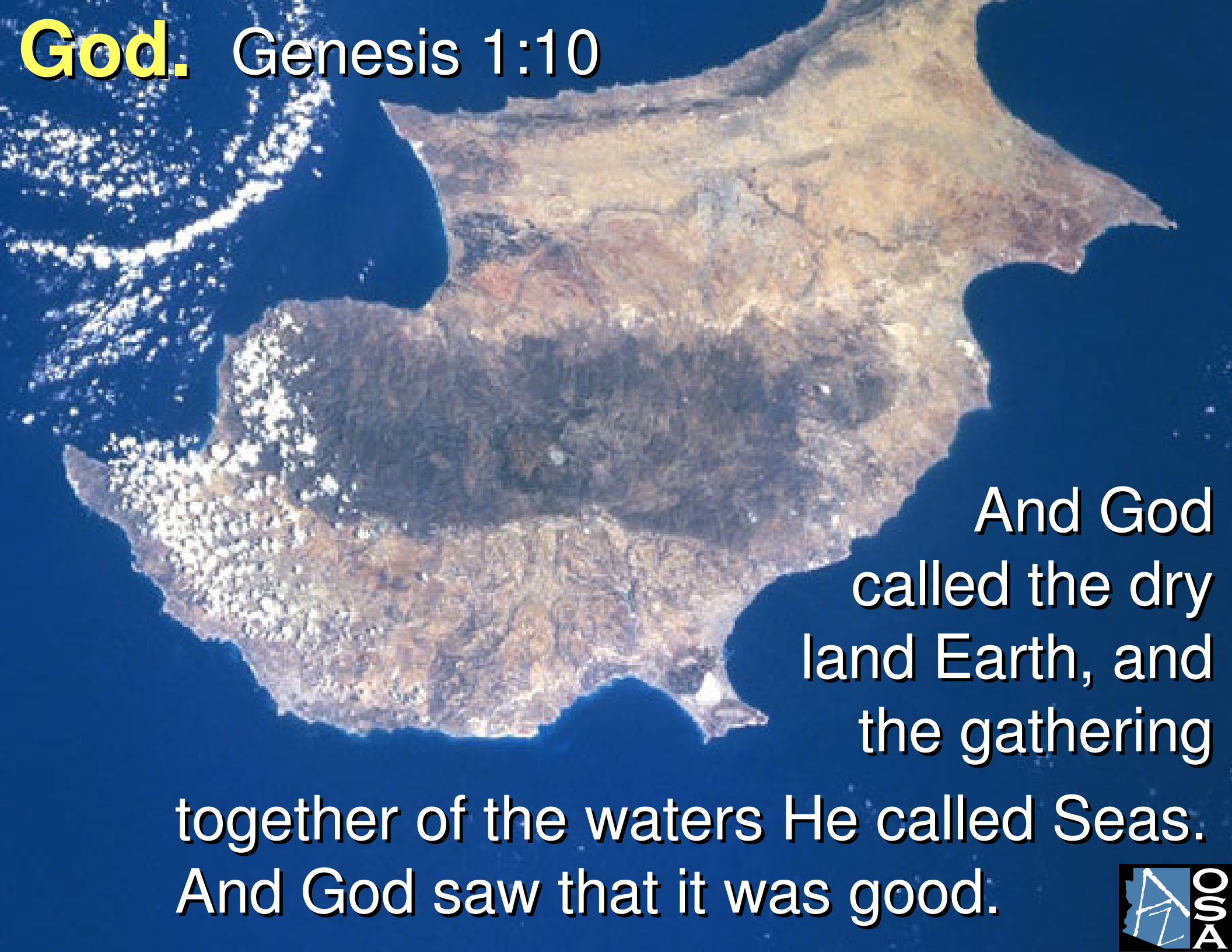

**On which day did God create plant life?**



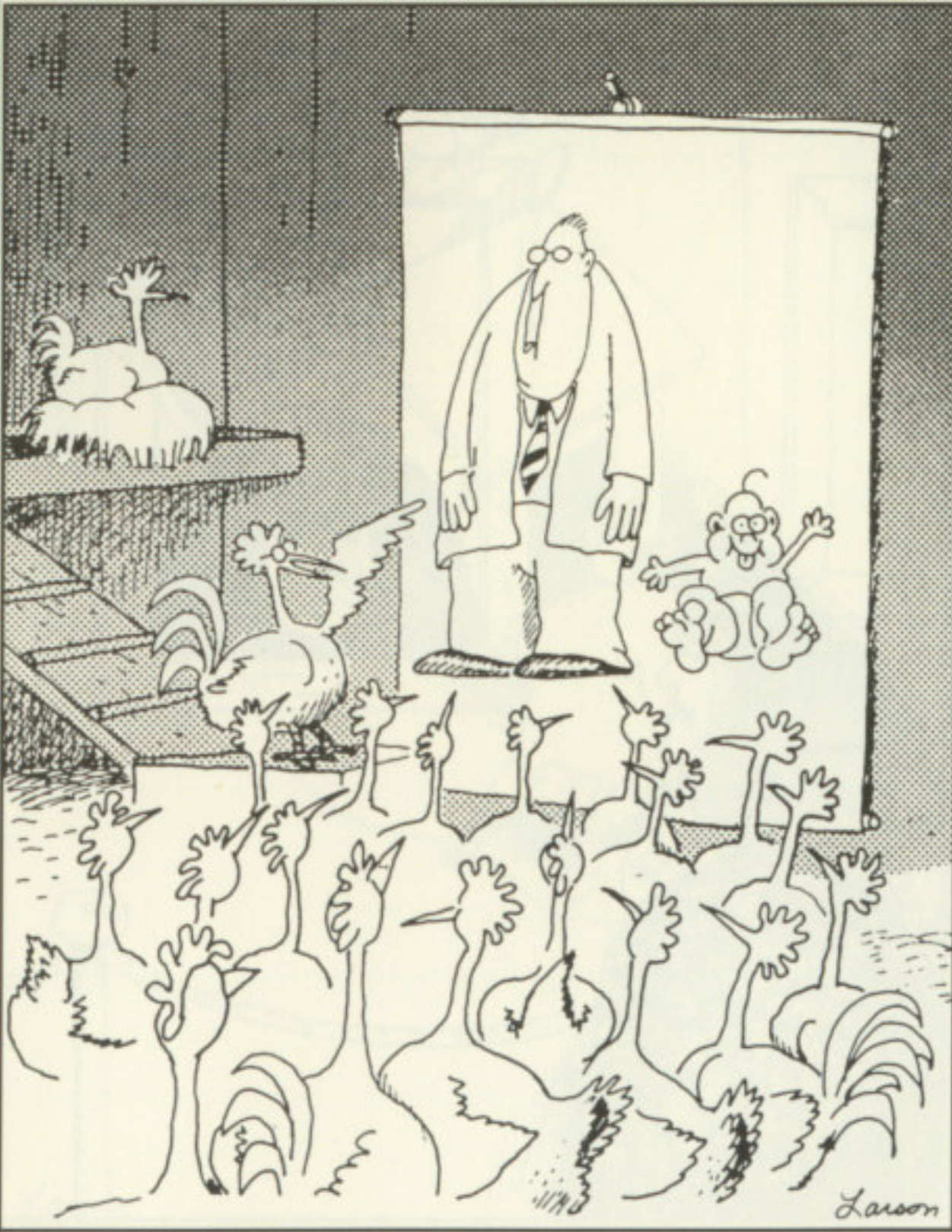


## Day 3.

“What came first .... the chicken or the egg?”






Both at the same

seasons, and for days and years;



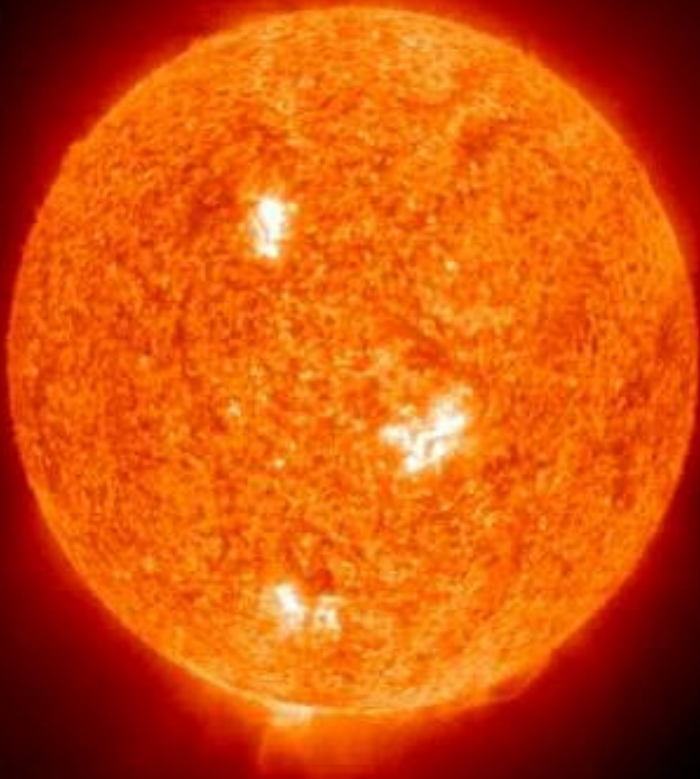


On which day did God create the sun?
