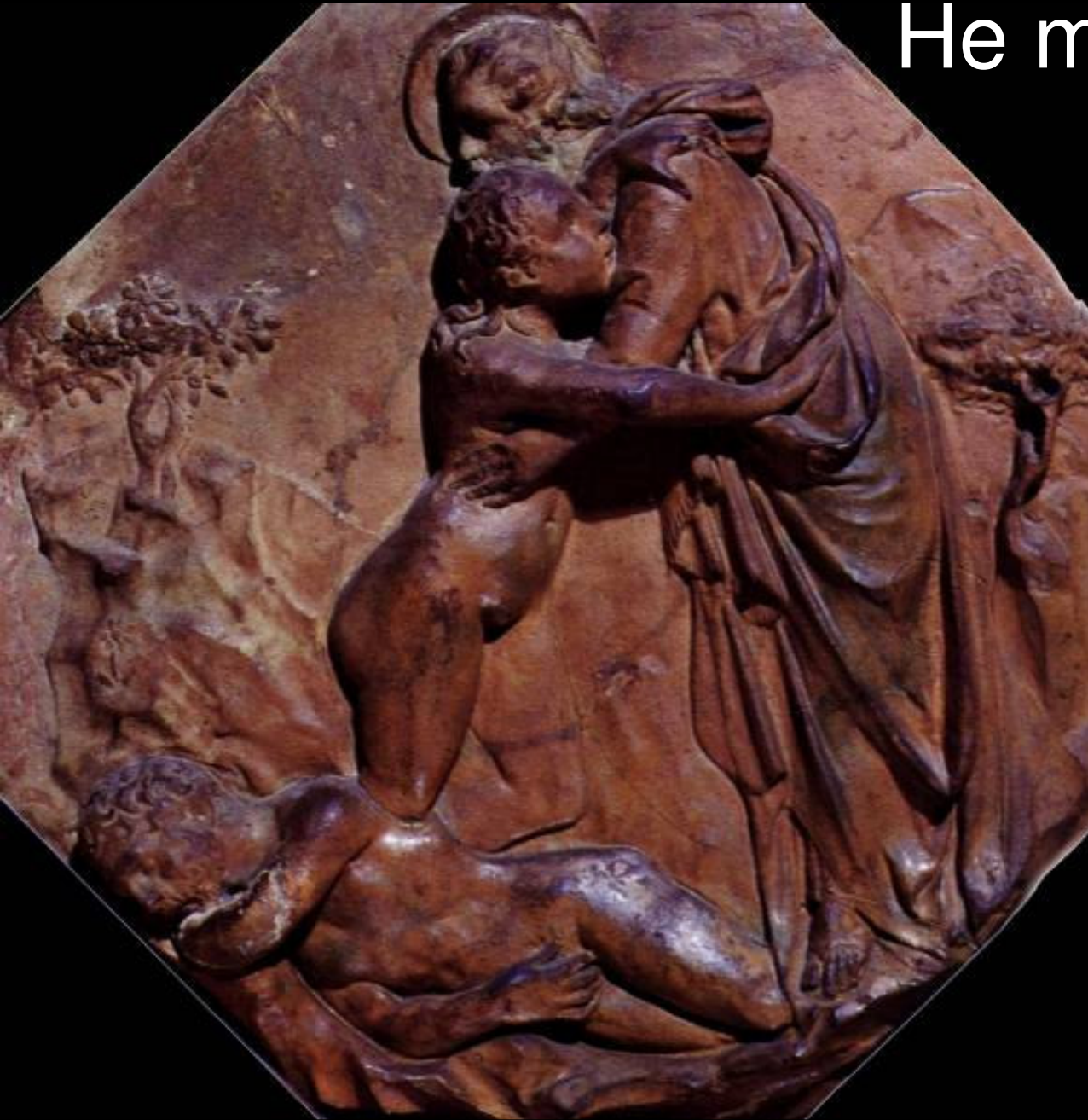


Where does God confirm that he created man in his likeness, and is that likeness physical or spiritual?

God is spirit,

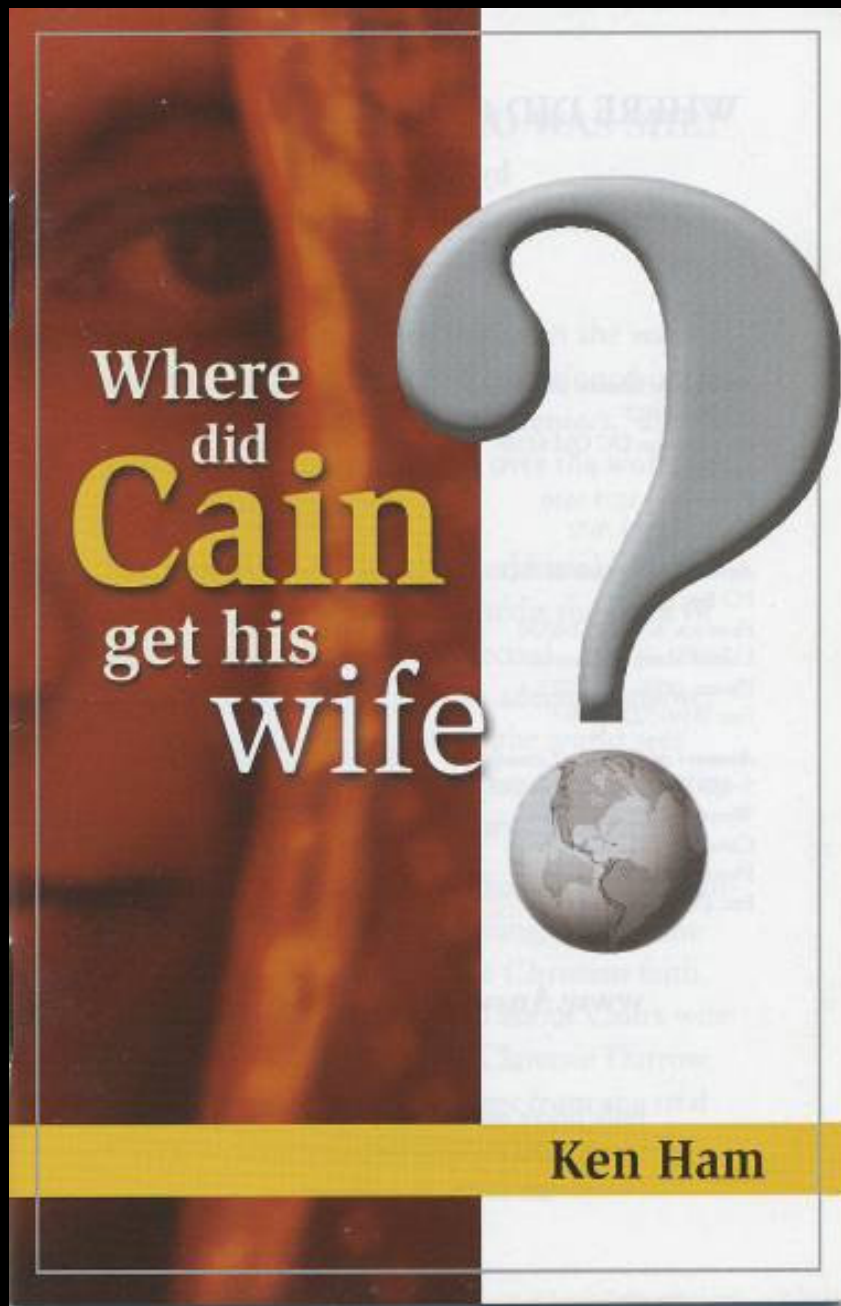
Where does God reconfirm his creation of Adam and Eve in one day?

Genesis 5:4

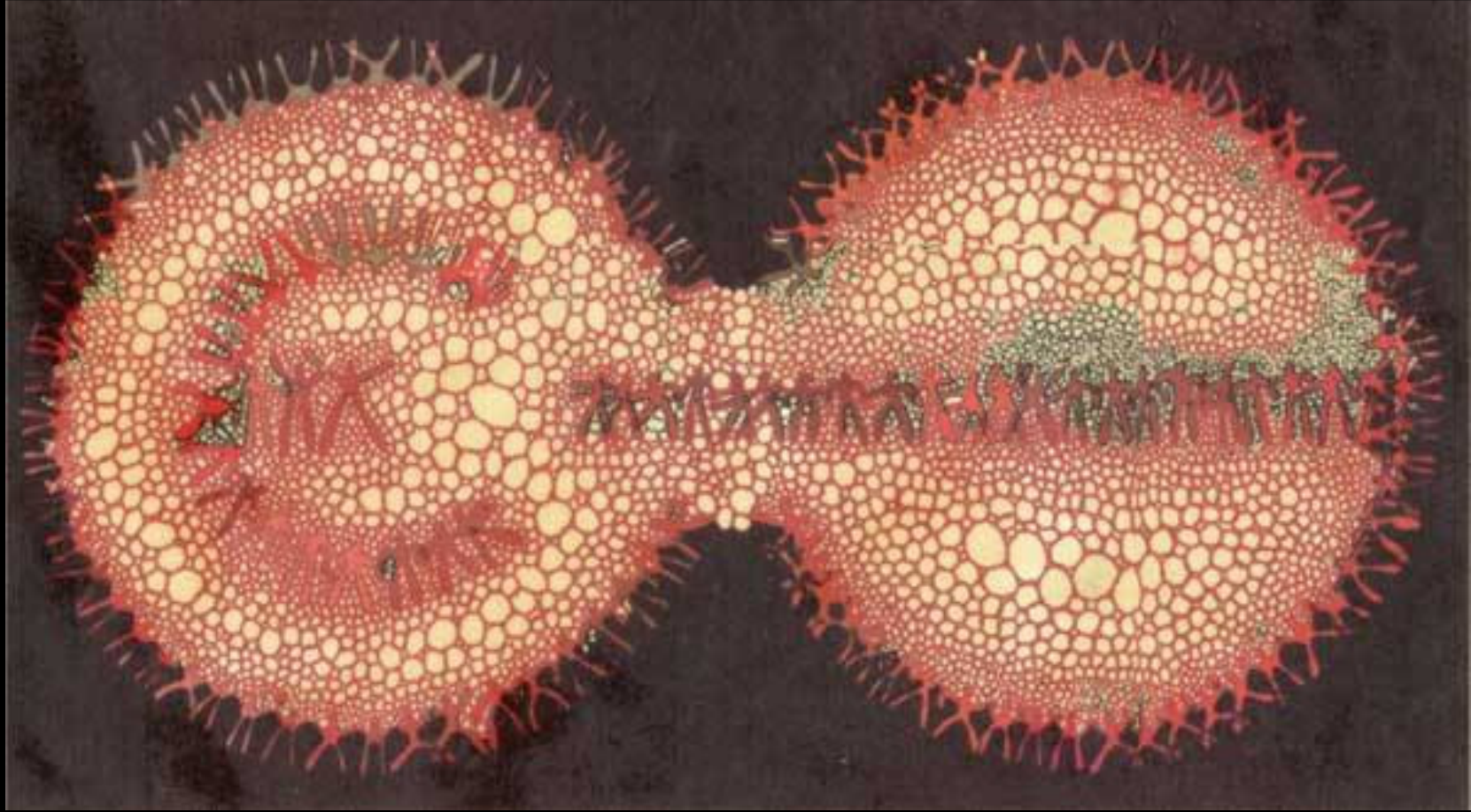
After he begot

and daughters.



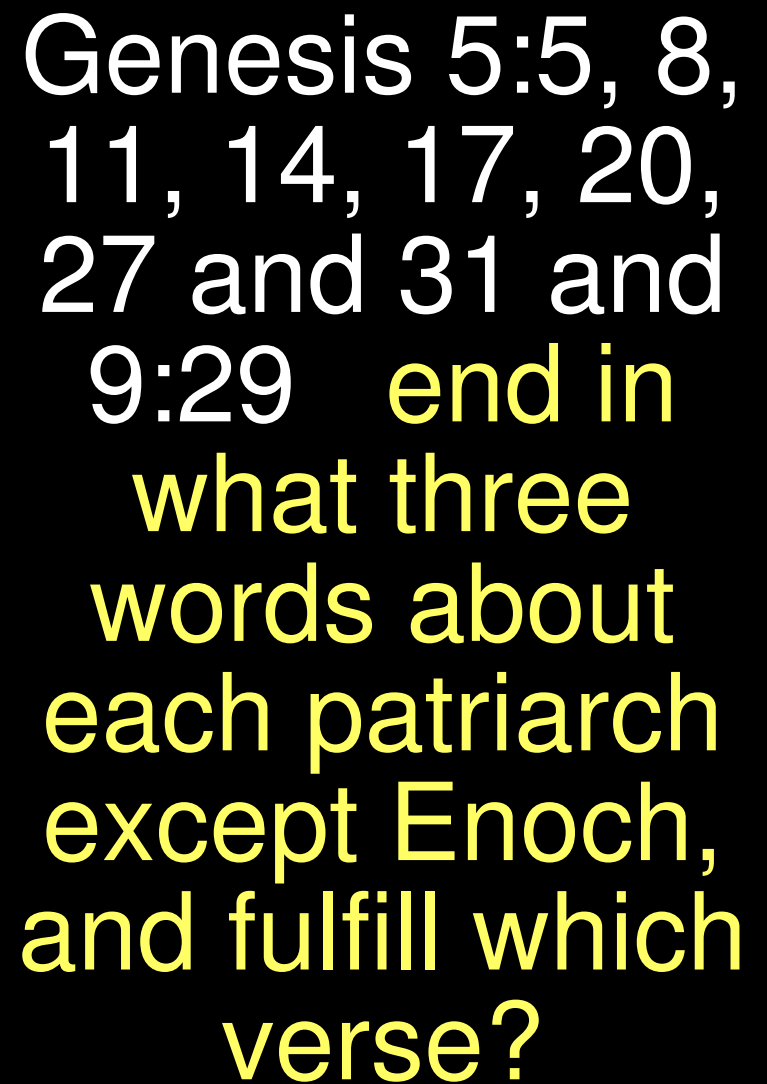
Was the marriage of Cain and his sister an act of incest?

God did not prohibit the marriage of close relatives until Leviticus 20, which was 2,500 years after creation. He knew that the accumulated burden of genetic mutations would become significant enough to cause disease and death.



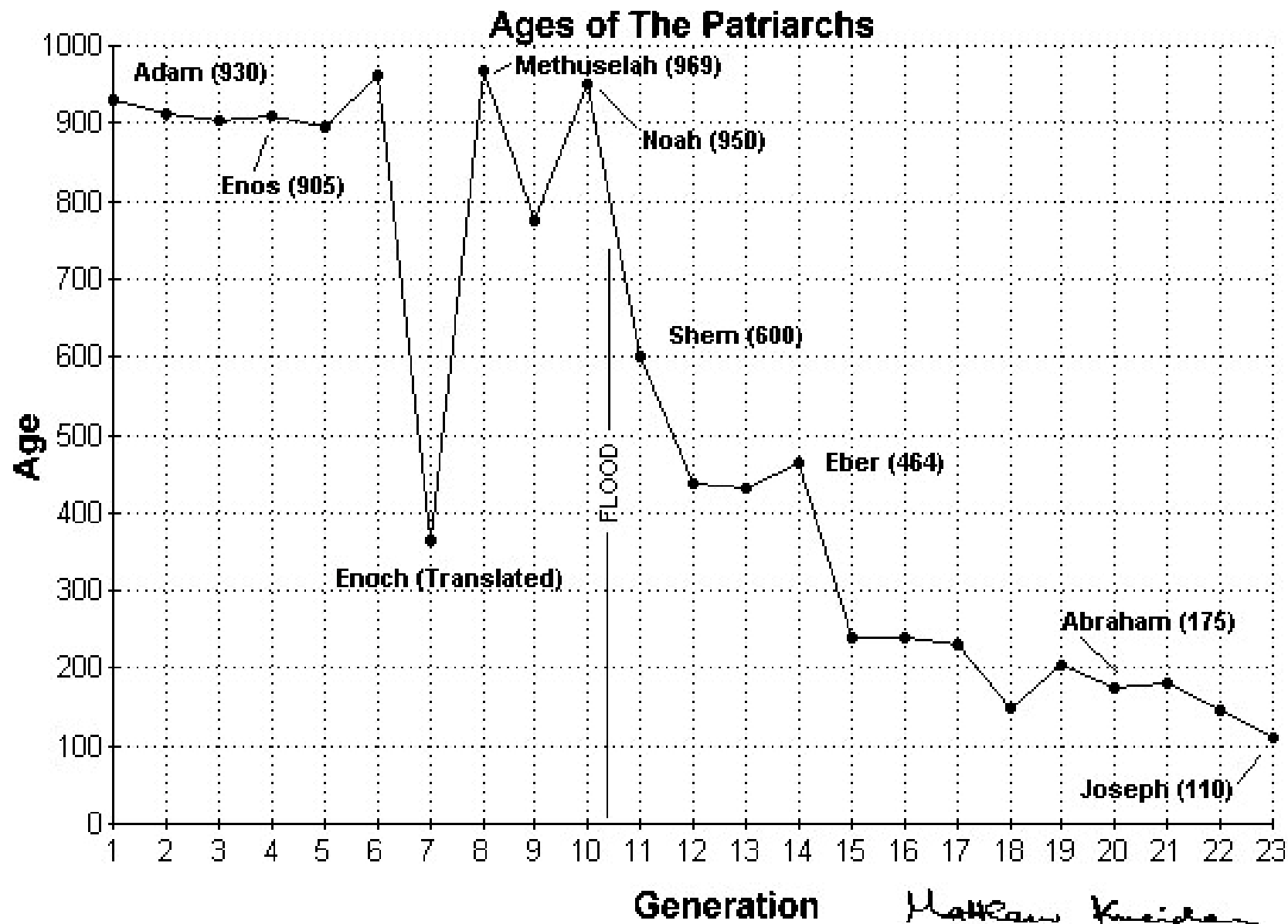

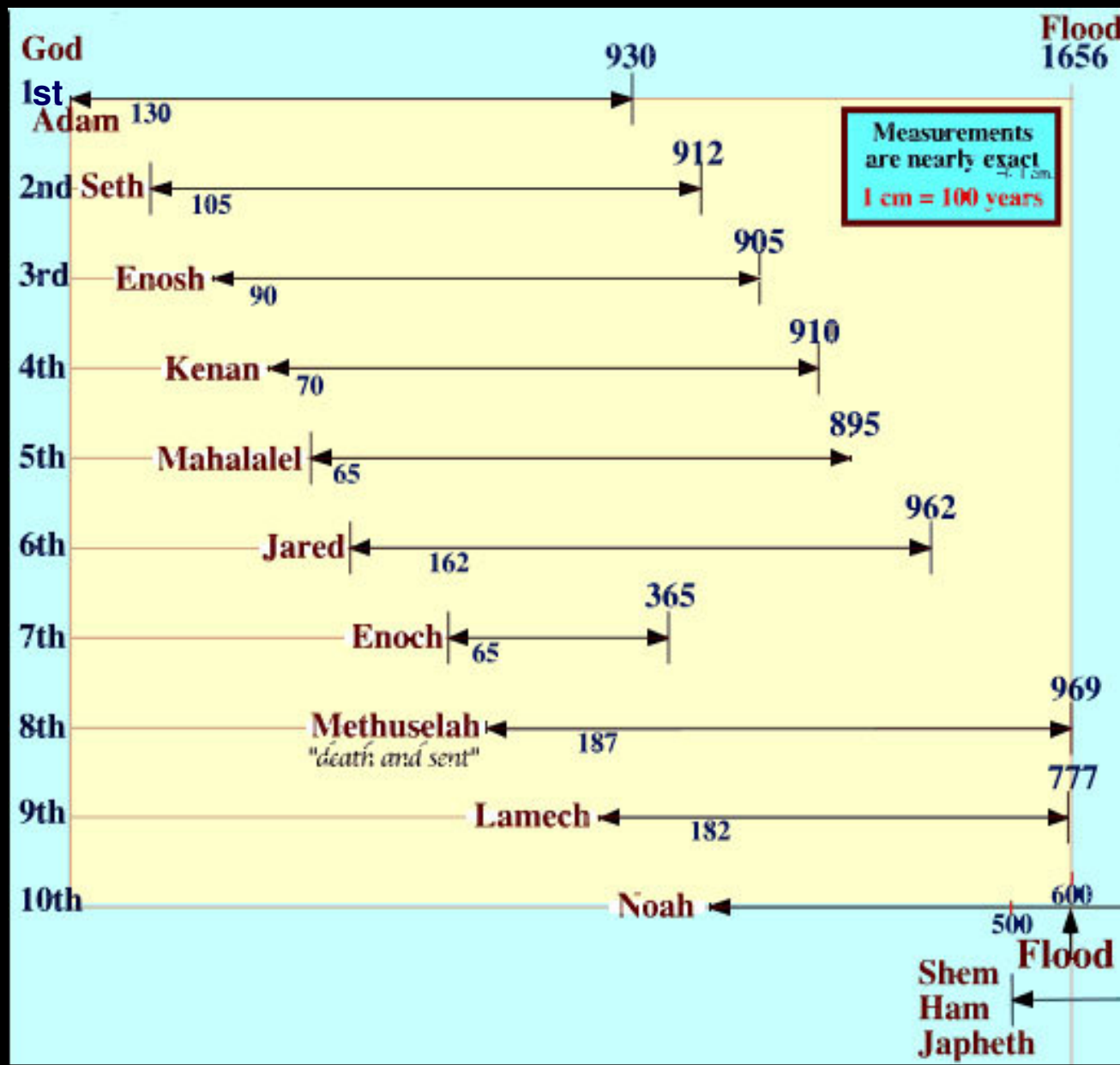
The average age of the antediluvian patriarchs (excluding Enoch) is 912 years. What does this tell us?



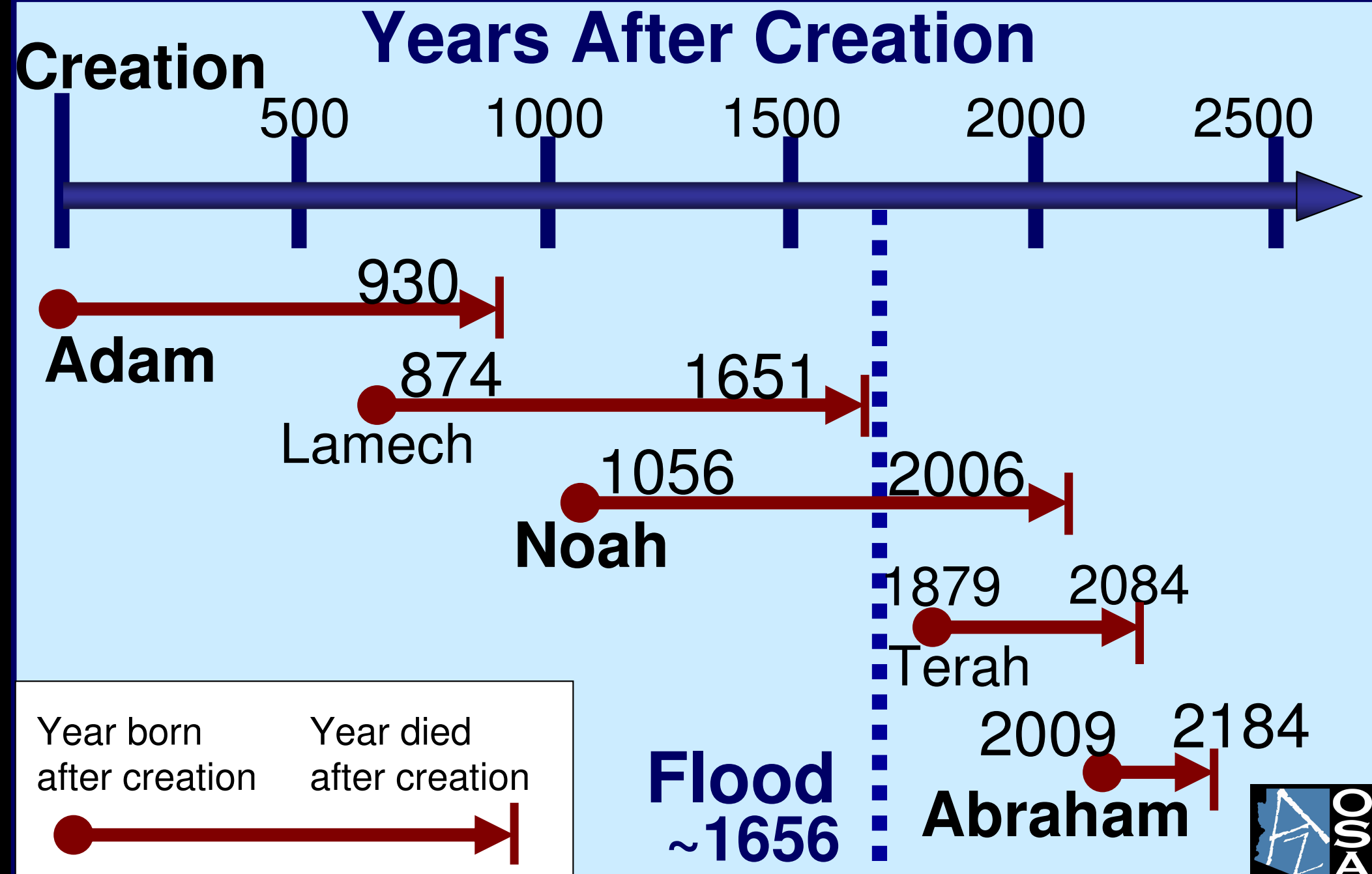


That God intended for man to have a very long life after the judgment at the Fall - until the judgment of the Flood.

“Methuselah”
mean and how
long did he live?

“It shall be sent” or “when he dies, judgment”. Prophecy by his father Enoch is implied, for Methuselah died the year of the great Flood of Noah.



Genesis 5:27
So all the days
of Methuselah
were nine
hundred and
sixty-nine
years: and
he died.

What does the name “Noah” mean?



Rest. Genesis 5:29 And he called his name Noah, saying, “This one will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the Lord has cursed.



What do “Shem”, “Ham” and “Japheth” mean?



Shem means “renown” or “name”. Ham means “hot”. Japheth means “beauty”, “let him enlarge” or “he that persuades”.



What implies that the original language of mankind was Hebrew?

תהלים קיט 89 - 96 Psalm 119:

89 לְעוֹלָם יִהְיֶה דְּבָרְךָ נִצָּב בַּשָּׁמַיִם: *Forever, O LORD¹,
Thy word is settled in heaven.*

90 לְדֹר וָדֹר אֱמוּנָתְךָ כֹּונֶנֶת אֶרֶץ וְתַעֲמֹד: *Thy faithfulness continues
throughout all **generations**;
Thou didst establish the earth, and it stands.*

91 לְמִשְׁפָּטֶיךָ עֲמָדוֹ הַיּוֹם כִּי הִכָּל עֲבָדֶיךָ: *They stand this day **according to Thine**
ordinances, for all² things are Thy servants³.*

92 לוֹלִי תוֹרָתְךָ שִׁעְשָׁעִי אֲזִי אֲבִדְתִּי בְּעָנִי: *If Thy law⁴ had not⁵ been my delight,
then I would have perished in my affliction.*

93 לְעוֹלָם לֹא־אֲשַׁכַּח פְּקוּדֶיךָ כִּי־בָם חִיֵּיתָנִי: *I will never⁵ forget Thy precepts,
for by them Thou has revived⁶ me.*

94 לִךָ־אֲנִי הוֹשִׁיעֵנִי כִּי פְקוּדֶיךָ דִּרְשָׁתִּי: *I⁷ am Thine, save me;
for I have sought Thy precepts.*

95 לִי קוֹו רָשָׁעִים לֹא־בִדְנִי עֲדָתְךָ אֲתַבּוֹנֶן: *The wicked⁸ wait **for me** to destroy me;
I shall diligently consider Thy testimonies⁹.*

96 לְכָל תִּכְלָה רָאִיתִי קֶץ רַחֲבָה מִצֻּוֹתֶיךָ מְאֹד: *I have seen¹⁰ a limit **to all**² perfection;
Thy commandment is exceedingly broad.*



All the names listed for people who lived before the judgment at Babel seem to have a distinctive meaning in Hebrew.

Person's Name	meaning	Hebrew letters	Pictograph meaning of the Hebrew letters
Adam	first blood	אָדָם	red man
Enoch	teacher	חֵנוֹךְ	
Noah	rest	נֹחַ	rest
Shem	name	שֵׁם	what destroys chaos
Ham	hot	חָם	the chamber of chaos
Japheth	he enlarges	יָפֶת
