

Where does God confirm that he created man in his likeness, and is that likeness physical or spiritual?






Genesis 5:1b

likeness of God.








Where does God reconfirm his creation of Adam and Eve in one day?








Genesis 5:2

Was the marriage of Cain and his sister an act of incest?





No!

God did not prohibit the marriage of close relatives until Leviticus 20, which was 2,500 years after creation. He knew that the accumulated burden of genetic mutations would become significant enough to cause disease and death.



The average age of the antediluvian patriarchs (excluding Enoch) is 912 years. What does this tell us?








That God intended for man to have a very long life after the judgment at the Fall - until the judgment of the Flood.




What else does this detailed listing of the ages of the Patriarchs at the birth of their sons give us?

Genesis 5:18

What does the name "Enoch" mean?





Teacher, initiated, dedicated.





Enoch walked with God for 360 years and then what happened?



God took him from the planet alive. Genesis 5:24 And Enoch walked with God, and he was not; for God took him.







Genesis 5:21
Enoch lived
sixty-five years,
and begat
Methuselah.

What does the name "Methuselah" mean and how long did he live?



"It shall be sent" or "when he dies, judgment". Prophesy by his father Enoch is implied, for Methuselah died the year of the great Flood of Noah.



Genesis 5:27 So all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred and sixty-nine years: and he died.



What does the name "Noah" mean?





Rest. Genesis 5:29 And he called his name Noah, saying, "This one will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the Lord has cursed.





What do "Shem", "Ham" and "Japheth" mean?





Shem means "renown" or "name". Ham means "hot". Japheth means "beauty", "let him enlarge" or "he that persuades".
